

What is videoconferencing?

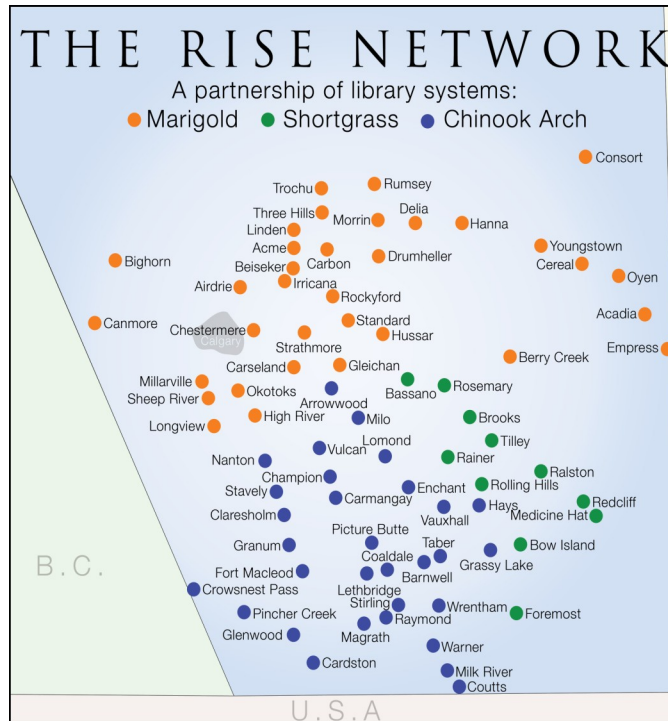


Videoconferencing is an interactive audiovisual technology that provides real time video and voice communication between videoconference units.

The technology gives you the ability to see and hear people from anywhere in the world, and for them to see and hear you.

Videoconferencing gives members of your community the opportunity to take part in formal instruction, to connect with guest speakers and experts, and to take part in professional activities and community events.

By eliminating the need to travel further than your local library, videoconferencing is both economical and a green solution.
